Declaration of the total number of voters for the Final Referendum Register & the Threshold

In accordance with the timeline issued by the Southern Sudan Referendum Commission, the Final Referendum Register was published on 8 January 2011. The Final Referendum Register incorporates the decisions on complaints and appeals.

As a result, the total number of registered voters is **3,932,588 (Three Million, Nine Hundred Thirty Two Thousand and Five Hundred Eighty Eight)**, divided as follows:

Registered voters in Southern Sudan **3,755,512**
Registered voters in Northern Sudan **116,857**
Registered voters in the 8 designated countries **60,219**

In accordance with Sec 41(2) of the Southern Sudan Referendum Act, the Southern Sudan Referendum shall be deemed legal if at least 60 percent (60%) of the registered voters cast their vote.

Therefore, the Commission hereby declares that, based on the above total number of registered voters, the threshold for the Referendum to be deemed legal will be reached if at least **2,359,553 (Two Million, Three Hundred Fifty Nine Thousand and Five Hundred Fifty Three)** voters cast their vote.
